In their projects they combine design research methods with radical pedagogy, conflict mediation techniques and DIY making. Currently, they are developing a participatory action research project in the Italian Alps - the area they grew up in - that experiments with how designers and architects can contribute to sustain and develop economies that contribute to progressive social change in rural areas. The framework they work with is informed by feminist approaches to more-than-human community economies and autonomist Marxist definitions of the commons.

Bianca works as a Research Fellow at Leeds College of Art, while Fabio is developing a practice-based PhD at the Sheffield School of Architecture.
